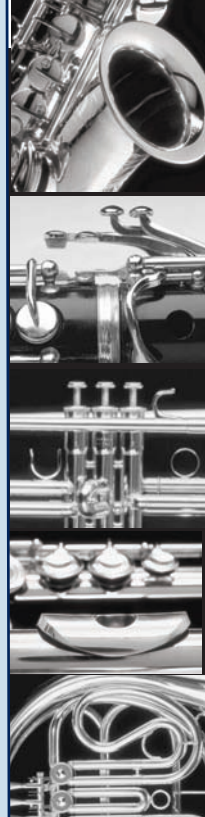

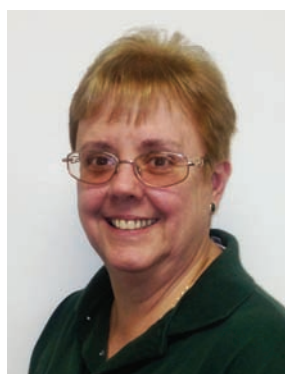

## SOUTHAMPTON COMMUNITY BAND *News & Notes*

The January 19th program is also a retrospective of the band's fifteen years of existence. The entire program consists of music performed by the band over the past decade and a half. Donna Creely has been a member of the band since its founding. Donna went to Lower Moreland High School. She attended Lebanon Valley College obtaining a degree in elementary education and a music minor. After earning a masters degree from Rider University, she worked as a first grade teacher for fifteen years before becoming a language arts specialist. She has taught at John B. Kelly Elementary in the Philadelphia School District her entire career. She and her husband Howard have two children; son Rob and daughter Bryne (and son-in-law Kevin), as well as 16-month-old granddaughter Kaylie. Donna is one active musician performing with the Warminster Symphony, the Delaware Valley Wind Ensemble, and of course the Southampton Community Band.



We asked Donna several questions about her participation with the band:

### ? How did you get involved with the band?

It was through the Warminster Symphony that I became acquainted with Dr. Guglielmi, who was to become the first director of the Southampton Band. On the eve of the band's first concert, Dr. G. asked me to play in the flute section. After that I was hooked.

### ? How many members were there originally?

I would say that we had approximately thirty participants.

### ? Where were the rehearsals held?

We practiced in the basement of the Redemption Episcopal Church on 2nd Street Pike.

### ? Are there any special moments you could highlight?

I loved performing a medley from Spike Jones. We needed a whole slew of percussionists and we only had one, Dale Brown. He ran his butt off covering all the parts!

### ? How has the band changed over these 15 years?

Obviously, we have grown in numbers. The music is much more difficult and the group's musicianship has improved. There are more students in the group and that is a plus. It is wonderful to see all generations working together to create beautiful music.
