Catherine Getchell began playing the trumpet at age nine. Since then, she has played in numerous bands, orchestras, and other groups. These include serving as principal

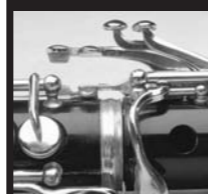
