## Welcome to Our Annual Scholarship Concert

On January 31, the band will present its scholarship concert in support of the scholarship program established for our graduating high school students.

The concert will have two distinctive themes. The first half of the program will feature different ensembles and soloists from the band. Some of them are performing in areas outside their usual participation in the band. Included will be a vocal solo by Maureen Scallatino, who typically performs on the flute, and a piano solo by Ruthanne Parker, a member of our clarinet section. Additionally there is a drum ensemble selection, a trumpet trio by three high school seniors, and a woodwind quintet selection.

The second half of the program will honor our founding director, Dr. Gil Guglielmi. Students from Centennial School District's two middle schools will join the band in appreciation of Dr. G's decades of service to the school district. This combined ensemble will perform three selections together including "Say it With Music", a work that was commissioned by the band to salute Dr. Guglielmi and this will be its premier performance.



Dr. Guglielmi was the founding conductor and now Director Emeritus of this band. As an educator, he taught instrumental music for 41 years in Centennial School District. Additionally he was active in the community and served as director of the Warminster Symphony for many years. He received a Doctor of Musical Arts from Combs College.



Behind the resume was a committed musician, who by his strong personality and limitless energy was able to forge together a band that today numbers seventy members. Because of his vision, we continue to host an annual "Salute to the Armed Forces" concert.
