Please join us on March 12th for an exciting and diverse program, honoring the memory of our co-founder and Conductor Emeritus, Dr. Gil Guglielmi.

I'll never forget the first time I communicated with Dr. Gil. I was a relatively new teacher, still living at my parent's house. It was a few weeks after the Eagles lost Super Bowl XXXIX (don't get me started,) and I was in my bedroom looking over some plans for the next day's lesson schedule. The landline phone rang and my mom came up to tell me someone named 'Gil' was on the line. As a teacher in Centennial School District, I knew of him from tales of our music program's history, but never spoke to him before. A soft, but authoritative voice was on the other line, "Michael, this is Gil Guglielmi. I direct the Southampton Community Band, and we are in need of a trombone player for next week's concert." I checked my schedule and confirmed my availability a few days later. That was the start of the 4-and-a-half seasons I spent with Dr. Gil in the band. I found Dr. Gil to be pleasant but firm in conversation, and relaxed but demanding on the podium; a set of personality traits that any music teacher would want to have. Even though my time working with him was short, he influenced me greatly.

It wasn't until his memorial service this past November did I realize the true scope of his influence. A large, diverse group of people came to the service, and all had wonderful stories to share. There was a true feeling of love and respect for him. The room was vibrant with people sharing memories together. It was a joyful morning and afternoon.

It is fitting that we deliver a musical tribute to Dr. Gil for our Scholarship Concert. The music will celebrate his Italian heritage, his time as an educator, and his patriotism. The band is working hard to give you yet another memorable night of music-making, even if we perform it with a heavy heart. Bring your family, bring a friend, and most importantly...bring a smile.
